Dear Parents/Guardians:

Spring break is upon us and soon seniors will begin to think about graduation and moving beyond Aliso Niguel. Indeed, this is a thrilling time for members of the Class of 2009! The administration encourages seniors to enjoy their final months and to join in all of the fun and excitement of the senior activities. It is important to remember that along with the fun of senior activities comes the responsibility for appropriate behavior during the remainder of the year both on campus and at all off-campus school activities.

This letter is to seek your assistance in reminding your son or daughter that appropriate conduct as defined below is **required** of all seniors, or they will risk suspension and loss of privileges beginning with senior activities and **including participation in the graduation ceremony**. Violation of some items will result in a recommendation to expel. Please discuss the importance of good behavior with your son or daughter so we can all avoid potential problems and the inevitable heartbreak, which will occur if memorable senior privileges are lost. These are times that will be remembered for a lifetime; let us not jeopardize participation in all of our exciting senior events!

- All established school rules and regulations must be obeyed.
- Seniors, as individuals or as a group, must not participate in school disruptions such as **senior ditch days, pranks, and/or vandalism of any type**.
- Use of alcohol or any controlled substance is forbidden and will result in a minimum five-day suspension and a recommendation for expulsion. It only takes a sip of champagne or any other alcoholic drink to be suspended and recommended for expulsion.

Seniors must maintain satisfactory progress toward obtaining the required 220 units for graduation in order to participate in senior events. Progress reports will be monitored to determine satisfactory grades and citizenship. Each senior must meet all Capistrano Unified School District requirements in order to earn a diploma and participate in our graduation ceremony. All deadlines for signing up for activities must be observed. A calendar of all of the senior events is enclosed.
